## We offer...

### Baptisms (aka Christenings) or Thanksgivings

These happen on the third Sunday of each month (except August) in our 11.00am service in the church. Please contact us if you want to celebrate the gift of a new child before God in a lively and unpredictable church service.

### Confirmation

This is an important service in which adults, young or otherwise, take on the promises and commitments that were made for them by their parents and godparents when they were Christened. For those who were not baptised as children, confirmation is linked with adult baptism.

### Weddings

Although there are many alternative options available to couples today, many still want to have a traditional wedding in Church and to seek God's blessing on their new life together. We love to have weddings at St Saviour's, so contact us to see if we can help you celebrate your big day with a church wedding to remember.

### Funerals

At St Saviour's we try to support people going through this experience by offering a funeral service which, we hope, will combine the sadness of saying goodbye whilst also celebrating the life of the one that we have lost.

### Healing & Wholeness

This ministry is available for anyone who feels a need to find God's love in transforming the difficult situation in which they find themselves to be in. Please contact us to see if we can offer you this prayer ministry.

### Community Project

We run a foodbank and a shop providing used children's clothing, furniture, household goods and other essential items at very low cost. We also host a job club and a savings & loans scheme. Also, we run the Friday Feast, an evening meal for families fighting poverty. Plus an allotment Project!

### Mothers Union

Our Mothers Union meet fortnightly on Tuesday afternoons in the church. It exists to provide Christian care for families.

### Men's Group

This meets most Wednesday evenings in the church. They seek to support men living out their faith in a complex world, whilst also having fun. Meetings include social events such as a snooker or curry night. Plus the **Old Codgers**. A joint meeting with the senior men of St Mark's. It meets on the first Tuesday of the month for lunch at the Acorn at Burncross. The mission statement is "grumpy old men having fun and seeking grace"! And the ladies now have their own **Lasses wot Lunch** on the second Monday of the month, same venue.
