### PCC Meeting on Monday 11th May 2026

Here's a summary of what your PCC discussed at the meeting. A copy of the full PCC Minutes is posted on the Notice Board at the back of church.

**Election of PCC Officers** - Lynne Lee was elected as Deputy Warden and co-opted onto the PCC. She will join Warden Kate Harrison and Deputy Warden Sue Wilson. Lesley Thulbourne was re-elected as Treasurer, and Suzanne Hague as Electoral Role Secretary. PCC Secretary position remains vacant. The role of Parish Safeguarding Officer has subsequently been filled by Susan Fiander.

The Standing Committee was also elected: - the chair being Priest-in-charge Rick Stordy, Warden Kate Harrison, Treasurer Lesley Thulbourne, David Field & Arthur Francis.

**Church Hall sale** – the hall is on the market and some interest has already been received. Advice is being taken from our nominated Estate Agents regarding the next steps.

**Focal Ministry Team & Oversight Ministers Report** – the PCC discussed the Oversight Minister's report and most recent Focal Ministry report under four main headings – losing people, building challenges, making disciples, and reduced resources. Initial thoughts were shared and recorded in the Minutes. It was agreed there was need for further conversations and prayer.

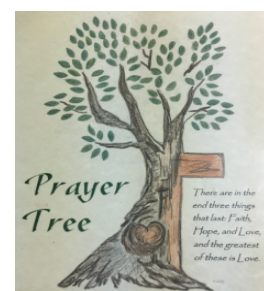
This month's social – **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 7pm – Miners Arms**. Please speak with any of the Men's Group if you are interested in joining them.
