Sponsored Night Hike – Saturday 4th July

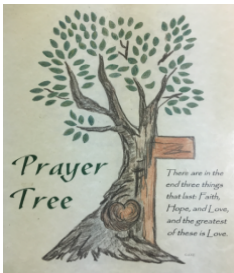
