Christian Aid Sponsored Night Hike – Saturday 4th July

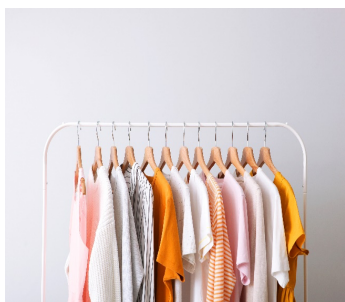


Dave, Simon and Chris were joined by Stuart Liversidge and his cousin Nigel

A big thank you to all who have supported them and the Charity. Donations totaled £500 and will go to Christian Aid's Venezuela Earthquake Appeal.

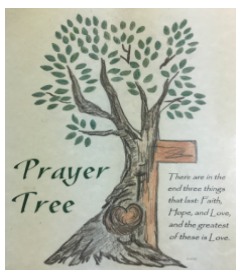
Clothes Sale Saturday 18th July – thank you!
