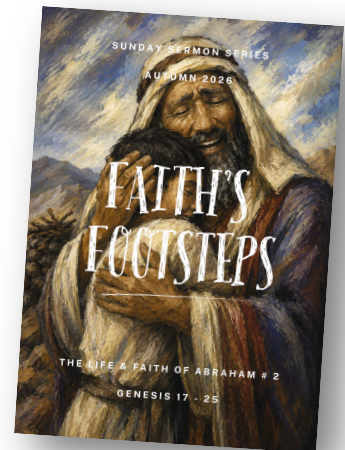
Late Morning Prayer @ SSC

St Saviours Food Pantry Fridays 1.00 - 3.00

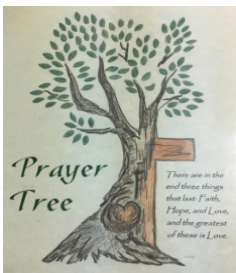
We continue to support those most in need in our community with food parcels on Fridays.
